## **Questions:**

- 1) Are you asking for -65 dBm coverage in the bathrooms and stairwells? Answer: No. -70dbm is sufficient.
- 2) What is the maximum number of concurrent users the new WLAN needs to support? Answer: The APs are spread entirely to meet the coverage area requirements for the convention's needs following the best practice method for predictive heat map analysis. The 4x4:4 802.11ax APs is enough to meet the needs of the facility.
- 3) How many devices per user are you accounting for on the New WLAN? Answer: The APs are spread entirely to meet the coverage area requirements for the convention's needs following the best practice method for predictive heat map analysis. What is the reason for PCCA reducing the requirement for MU-MIMO from 8x8 to 4x4? Answer: The APs are spread entirely to meet the coverage area requirements for the convention's needs following the best practice method for predictive heat map analysis.
