Clarifications:

- 1) Please add 2 additional Dante boxes to the quote.

Questions:

- 1) Please confirm what model is being requested in the Add. Alt. 1 item number 7 for Clear-Com. Is it the FSE-BASE – FreeSpeak Edge Base Station (16 beltpacks)? Or is it the FSII-BASE-II-5-X5 – FreeSpeak II Base Station (5 beltpacks)? **Answer: Please use FSE-BASE – FreeSpeak Edge Base Station (16 beltpacks) option.**
- 2) QSC Touch-Mix mixers are End of Life. We added the Yamaha DM3 as a potential replacement. Please advise if approved replacement. **Answer: Yes, Yamaha DM3 is acceptable and preferred.**
- 3) There is a Dante option for the Yamaha Mixers if PACC wants to go that route since they are already using Dante in other capacity. There is a cost increase, but it may give them more flexibility in the long run. **Answer: No issue with this. Please include the Dante option with your price/bid.**
- 4) No Shure Transmitters were called out for the Quad Receivers (We Added Handhelds “SM58’s” and Belt packs “with WL185’s” as an option to cover all the quad receivers). **Answer: We are good with this. Please include pricing in your bid.**
- 5) We Added four Furman’s as an option for the racks for the Quad Wireless Receivers (Racks were listed under the accessories so I added the style racks we use for event staging where the racks lift out and the transmitters are stored underneath in foam). **Answer: This is not needed.**
- 6) There was only one warrantee listed for Barco. Each projector will need a separate warrantee to be valid. **Answer: Please include warranties for each.**
- 7) The Yamaha/Allen & Heath Dante Stage boxes read like they need/want one or the other. I only placed the Yamaha units in the BOM. Please confirm this is the case. **Answer: This is fine. It is one or the other. Yamaha is preferred.**
- 8) On the Clear-Com quote there are warranty options. Would you want to add the warranties for these devises? **Answer: Yes, please include warranties.**
