

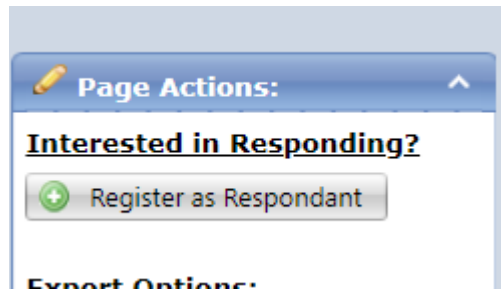

  - c. Hit “View” under the Solicitation Project you want to Register for

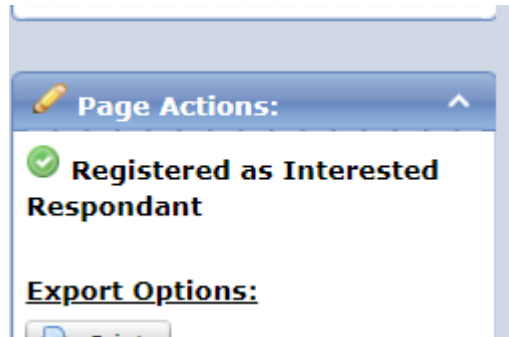
